IVARA

A. Measure a Ring You Already Own



- Identify the finger you want to wear a ring on.
- Select a ring that fits comfortably on the finger.
- Use a ruler to measure the ring's inner diameter in millimeters.
- Match your measurement with our precision chart below.
- For the most accurate sizing, refer to our detailed scale.

If you want the accurate size, refer to this scale. Use a ruler to ensure the printed sample on the right is exactly 40 mm. To do this, make sure your print settings are not set to scale or shrink.



B. The Ivara Touch: Our Bespoke Ribbon Method

- Choose a fine ribbon that complements the elegance of the ivara experience.
- Carefully wrap it around the base of the your finger.
- Mark the point where the ends meet with precision.
- Match the measurement to our sizing chart.
- Verify the result for a flawless fit.



C. Use a Ring Size Tool

- Tools are simple plastic or metal instrument that measure finger ring.
- Most tools look like a mini measuring tape or a set of plastic rings of different sizes.
- Slip your finger through the tools to check which size feels snug but comfortable.

This method is ideal if you often buy rings or plan to gift more than one.

2. Measuring Guide For Bracelet & Bangles

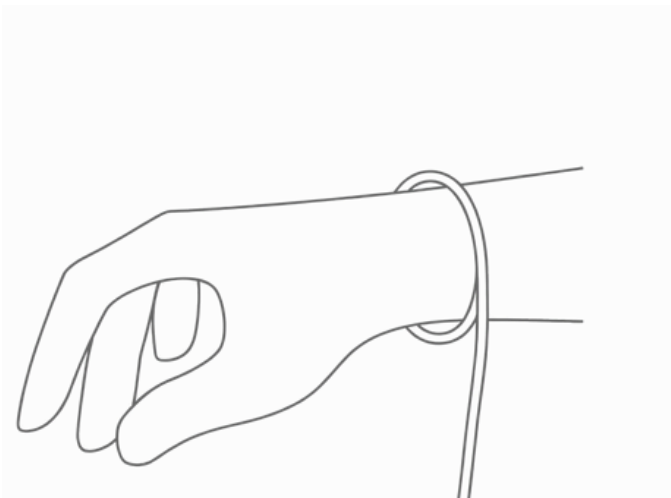

Here are two simple methods to measure your wrist and find the

Perfect fit using our conversation chart.

A. Precious Method: measuring tape

- Wrap a measuring tape snugly around your wrist bone.
- Carefully record the measurement.



B. Measure Your Wrist

- Wrap a measuring tape or a piece of string around your wrist where you normally wear a bracelet.
- Make sure the tape is comfortable and not too tight.
- Note the measurement and compare it with our bracelet size chart below.
- If you are between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size for a more comfortable fit.
- All measurements are approximate and may vary slightly depending on the bracelet design.

A. Necklace Length Guide

- Necklace length is measured from one end of the clasp to the other end of the chain when the necklace is laid flat.
- The total length determines where the necklace will sit on the neck and chest.
- Necklace length is calculated by measuring the entire chain from clasp to end.
- The selected length determines how the necklace rests on the neckline, ranging from a close-fitting choker to longer opera styles that fall on the chest.
